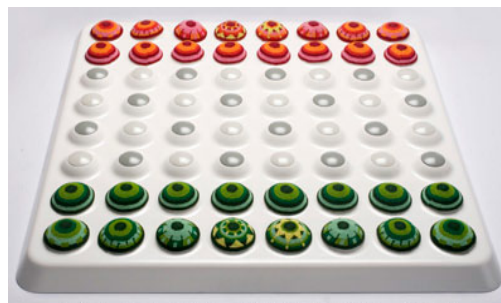


Rejuvenate Yourself Through JTS

From TI's successes—that also gave rise to Camp Ramah, Reconstructionist Judaism, the New York Bureau of Jewish Education, and the modern congregational school education system—came the roots of the JTS that thrives under the leadership of [Chancellor Arnold M. Eisen](#) and his vision: the firm commitment to Torah and Jewish tradition in modern American life. In short, the opportunity to live in two cultures simultaneously, while fully, richly, and deeply engaged in both.
