Cantor Nancy Abramson assumed her position as director of the H. L. Miller Cantorial School and College of Jewish Music of The Jewish Theological Seminary in summer 2011. Previously, she was cantor at New York City's Park Avenue Synagogue, where she served for 14 years. She is a graduate of the Dual Degree program of JTS's Albert A. List College of Jewish Studies and Columbia University, and received her cantorial education at JTS. Cantor Abramson is senior vice president of the Cantors Assembly—the first woman to hold any office in that organization—and a member of the Zamir Choral Foundation board and of the Women Cantors Network. She has performed at Carnegie Hall and Avery Fischer Hall, and sung with the Rinat Choir in Israel.
